2010 NALA SCHOLARSHIP AWARD ONE (1) \$500 AWARD FOR THE 35th ANNUAL NALA CONVENTION

The NALA Scholarship Award will be presented at IALA's 2010 Mid Year Meeting which is held prior to NALA's 35th Annual Convention to be held July 11-14, in Jacksonville, Florida. The general rule is that the scholarship funds will be paid directly to NALA on behalf of the recipient for attendance at the convention, with the remainder of the funds paid to the recipient. **IF YOU DO NOT FULLY INTEND TO ATTEND THE NALA CONVENTION, PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT THIS APPLICATION.**

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN
APRIL 17, 2010.

Please note: You neither need to be a NALA member nor a CLA to attend the NALA convention to qualify for this scholarship.

Qualifications to receive the NALA Scholarship Award are as follows:

- 1) Must be a member of IALA at the time of applying for the scholarship.
- 2) Must be a member of IALA at the time of the NALA convention.
- 3) Must be willing and able to attend the 2010 NALA convention to be held in Jacksonville, Florida to be held July 11-14, 2010
- 4) Provide an essay at the time of submission of this application on the topic attached to this form.
- 5) Submit a report on the NALA Convention to the IALA Scholarship Committee for publication in the *Original Notice* within one month after the recipient's return.

The IALA Scholarship Committee will determine if the applicant meets all requirements and will oversee this scholarship. **All scholarship applications must be submitted to the IALA Scholarship Committee and postmarked no later than April 17, 2010.** The IALA Scholarship Committee will judge the essays. The recipient will be announced and presented with the NALA Scholarship at IALA's Mid Year Meeting.

An alternate will be selected at the time of judging, should the selected recipient, for any reason, be unable to attend the 2010 NALA Convention. If awarded and the recipient is unable to attend, the recipient of the NALA Scholarship will be disqualified from applying for the scholarship for three full years following the award. In such case, the applicant may reapply for this scholarship for the NALA Convention to be held in 2013.
